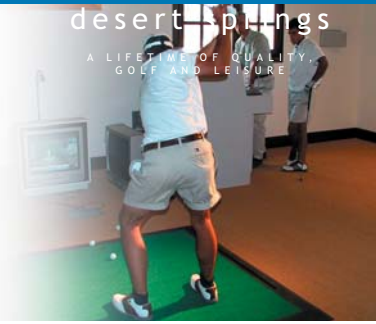


## RESORT MEMBERSHIP



The key to entry to this very exclusive and privileged category is ownership of an Almanzora Bay home. This is because the Desert Springs Golf Club only offers the chance to nominate Resort Members to the registered owners of residential properties built by The Almanzora Bay Group and at the Desert Springs Resort. For Almanzora Bay first time home buyers only at the Resort, there are additional benefits, for which click the adjoining link.



The privilege of nomination, rather than direct Membership, is extended by the Club to the current registered owners of Almanzora Bay homes at Desert Springs, so that they can if they wish nominate someone other than themselves, in the event for example that they do not play golf themselves. Property Owners can therefore nominate themselves or may nominate someone else of their choosing.

Resort Membership is privileged, because when other memberships and public rounds become scarce or cease to be available as a result of the limits on course capacity arising from the Club's quality golf objectives, then those qualifying for Resort Membership will have priority for access to the Club. Of no less significance and more immediate importance, Resort Members enjoy a reduced level of annual subscriptions and joining fees.

The privilege of nomination and the resulting Resort Memberships are dependant upon continuing ownership of a property at Desert Springs. In the event that the property is sold, the Resort Membership will lapse at the end of the year, but the Member may of course rejoin as an Open or other category of Member, subject to payment of the difference only in the applicable joining fees and annual subscriptions.

Access to Membership will therefore be primarily through property ownership, ensuring the future exclusivity of the Club, as well as enhancing property resale values, which will carry with them this unique facility of nomination. Ownership of property on the Resort will always have clear and valuable advantages.

Resort membership is itself divided into two categories to cater for the different needs of those who live in their property on the resort, "Resort Resident Members", and those who cannot take full year round advantage of the facilities, "Resort Non-Resident Members". Resort Non-Resident membership has been specifically designed for those, who live overseas or elsewhere in Spain, using their property for occasional visits and as a holiday home or who, for whatever reason, only plan to play a limited amount of golf.
